Astronauts visiting March 24 Roberta Bondar, Ken Money to return our crest

Roberta Bondar will be at Ryerson March 24 to present President Terry Grier with

the Institute crest that went into orbit aboard the space shuttle *Discovery*.

The ceremony begins at 11 a.m. in lecture theatre L72. **Ken Money**, who was Dr. Bondar's back-up for the shuttle mission, is also scheduled to attend.

Dr. Bondar, awarded a Ryerson Fellowship last spring, will talk about her experiences in space and will answer questions from the audience. The ceremony is open to all members of the Ryerson Community, although seating in L72 is limited.

Dr. Bondar will present Mr. Grier with a small, cotton Ryerson crest that was in-

cluded in the shuttle's payload by the Canadian Space Agency. The payload

included the flags of a number of organizations, institutions, and cities associated with Dr. Bondar, including her hometown of Sault Ste. Marie, her first stop on what is a cross-Canada tour.

In conjunction with Dr.
Bondar's research into bloodflow under weightless conditions, a Ryerson research
team based at the Centre
for Advanced Technology
Education has been working

on experiment methodology, modelling, evaluation, data collection, and analysis through a contract with the Canadian Space Agency.
